## **How to Apply to add your land to an Ag Security Area**

Fill out Proposal for the Creation or Modification of an Agricultural Security Area

(\*\* all owners must sign) following all directions. Any assistance needed for mapping or tax parcel numbers can be given by the Farmland Preservation Office.

Submit to township (preferably in person if possible). Ask for a receipt that shows the date that it was submitted.

If submitted by mail, submit by Certified Mail return receipt as on the instructions.

The Township will do all of the next steps. The Township has 180 days to act on the application. Usually the Townships simply lets the 180 days lapse and then they pass a Resolution and have it recorded at the Lehigh County Recorder of Deeds.

The Township send a copy of the recorded Resolution to the landowner, to the Lehigh County Farmland Preservation Office, and the Lehigh Valley Planning Commission.
