2019 Stray Animal Assistance with the Sanctuary at Haafsville

The Sanctuary at Haafsville's stray animal assistance will seek to provide humane, effective and economical services for your municipality and its residents. We will be providing this service with the intent to return as many animals as possible to their homes.

FREE ROAMING DOGS FOUND BY THE PUBLIC

- The Sanctuary at Haafsville can be contacted on 484-285-5445.
- The Sanctuary at Haafsville will accept stray dogs from the public and police between 9 AM and 7 PM that are picked up running at large in the Municipality. The Sanctuary needs to be contacted first at 484-285-5445 to arrange for the dog to be received by the Sanctuary. The Sanctuary will encourage those who find these dogs to put up flyers where the dog was found to increase the probability of reuniting the dog with its home.
- The Sanctuary at Haafsville will post photos of all found dogs on multiple websites.
- Members of the public can call us on 484-285-5445 to see the dog and hopefully determine it is their missing canine companion!
- After 72 hours, all dogs received from the Municipality not reunited with their owners will be made available for adoption.
- All dogs will be vaccinated as needed, treated for fleas, wormed and scheduled to be neutered if not returned to their homes.

FREE ROAMING FERAL CATS

- As part of The Sanctuary's stray animal assistance, the Municipality's free roaming feral cats will receive TNR – Trap, Neuter, Return.
- Members of the public with free roaming cats should call the No Nonsense Neutering feral cat line: 866-820-2510, ext. #4, or visit www.nnnlv.org and click on TNR. Callers need to identify themselves as residents of this Municipality with free roaming cats that need TNR. Loaner traps are available and trapping assistance will for the elderly or disabled will be sought. A co-pay of \$15 is requested, but if the resident is unable to afford the \$15 co-pay the cat will still be neutered.

FREE ROAMING FRIENDLY CATS

- The Sanctuary at Haafsville can be contacted on 484-285-5445.
- The Sanctuary at Haafsville will accept friendly cats between 9 AM and 7 PM that are picked up running at large in the Municipality, on a space available basis. A waiting list will be maintained should we not be able to take the cat immediately.
- The Sanctuary at Haafsville will post photos of all found cats on multiple websites.
- Members of the public can call us on 484-285-5445 to see the cat and hopefully determine it is their missing feline companion!
- After 72 hours, all friendly cats received from the Municipality not reunited with their owners will be made available for adoption.
- All cats will be vaccinated as needed, treated for fleas, wormed and scheduled to be neutered if not returned to their homes.

OWNED DOGS AND CATS

- The Municipality is not responsible for owned animals that people wish to relinquish.
- Owners who find themselves having to give up their dogs and friendly cats can contact The Sanctuary at Haafsville on 484-285-5445. They need to contact us as soon as possible when they find they need to rehome their animal.
- Every effort will be made to help them find new homes for their pets, starting with posting the pets on The Sanctuary at Haafsville and Petfinder.com websites and having the owners bring the pets to adoption days.
- Dogs and cats that are part of this program and do not find homes directly from their present homes will be the first accepted into our shelter as space becomes available.
- Normal shelter policies for the intake of these cats and dogs will be required.
- The Sanctuary at Haafsville will determine in questionable cases if an animal being surrendered is a stray or an owned dog or friendly cat.
