MEETING MINUTES
HELD VIA ZOOM MOBILE MEETING APP DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND GOVERNOR
WOLF'S STAY AT HOME ORDER**

The Lowhill Township Board of Supervisors meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman Richard Hughes. Also present were George Wessner, Jr.; Vice Chairman; Robb Werley, Member; Brian Carl, Administrator and Secretary Jill Seymour.

Brian explained that he was violating our noise ordinance and this is a free warning, if it continues, we will have to file a civil complaint. Mr. Lagler agreed to go over to Warden Road in the game lands to shoot, but was not happy about not being able to ride his ATV on the road, etc. Rick Hughes received several complaints from residents via e mail and responded to every one of them. He asked the residents to come to a meeting, once the pandemic is over.

Richard Hughes said the property on Route 100 that has the detailing shop is once again in violation. Brian will check it out. The Bogart property is full of junk and in violation of a judgement that was not paid in Lowhill Township's favor. The property is still not cleaned up and may be worse than it was. Brian will go check on it.
